Warning – This is the antithesis of boring, branded wine. Natural wine is something quite individual, very pleasurable and occasionally extraordinary. Because of the way they are made some of the wines are fragile and, in order to be properly appreciated, are best served cool.

315	7 Rue de la Pompe, VdT, Languedoc 2010 (Fr) <small>'A Languedoc Syrah that just soars out of the glass with its freshness and purity. It's bone dry and tastes super-healthy, finishing bone dry after a great mouthful of fruit - quite a contrast to more souped-up, industrial products. It is just 12.5% alcohol and has had no added sulphur' – Jancis Robinson. An interesting, funky nose behind which shines oodles of juicy pure fruit and a vibrancy like nothing else.</small>	5.4	7.4	29.5
811	Beaujolais Villages, Cambon, Beaujolais 2011 (Fr) <small>Gamey, cherry scented offering from natural wine pioneer M Lapiere it is refreshing & very drinkable. From eighty year old vines, 'in the murk lurks a jungle of brambly fruit with a whiff of the beast' (a wonderful quote from Cave de Pyrene). Wild stuff.</small>	5.6	7.7	30.8
903	Dolcetto d'Asti, Roagna, Piedmont 2010 (It) <small>Very bright, youthful cherry fruit and mineral nose follows through to the feather light, zippy palate.</small>	6.2	8.5	34
804	Carignan, Villalobos 2010 (Ch) <small>Sensuous, delicate, naturally made wine from wild growing vines in the Artist Valley, Colchagua, Chile. Villalobos is neither filtered nor fined and nothing is added to the wine which is allowed to age slowly and naturally in French oak barrels. It is the colour of a dark rosé, there is no extraction or concentration, just clean, lifted, almost graphite fruit supported by clean acids.</small>	7.3	9.9	39.7
805	NV La Soif du Mal, 'Les Foulards Rouge', Roussillon (Fr) <small>Natural winemaking here, with almost no SO2, giving very pure, lush berry fruit & aromatic, sunbaked herbs. 70% Syrah, 30% Grenache, think somewhere between New Zealand Pinot Noir and a deliciously fresh Gamay from Beaujolais. It's light, fragrant and aromatic. 'Soif du Mal' translates, I guess, as a wicked thirst, and this is the sort of wine that will certainly satisfy a thirst.</small>	7.6	10.5	41.8
801	Régnié, Charley Thevenet, Beaujolais 2010 (Fr) <small>Like a really fresh, silken Beaune Pinot Noir. Charley has produced a wine that proves why Beaujolais is back in vogue.</small>	7.9	10.9	43.5
807	Underwater Syrah, Cellar Foot, Lammershoek, Swartland 2010 (RSA) <small>Craig Hawkins has taken a few barrels of his best Syrah & submerged them underwater for 11 months! 108	Réserve de Gassac Blanc, Languedoc 2011 (Fr) <small>Predominantly Viognier with Marsanne, Roussanne and Chardonnay from 25 year old vines. It is unoaked. A fleshy nose of tropical fruits and green herbs. Soft and ripe on the palate with a lingering and aromatic finish and a concentrated mineral backbone.</small>	4.4	6.1	23.4
213	The LAM Chenin / Viognier, Lammershoek, Swartland 2010 (RSA) <small>Fresh fruit and acid dominate this Chenin Blanc (60%) and Viognier (40%) blend. On the nose a sense of coolness is the first impression then the subtle fresh flavours of Chenin and Viognier become apparent.</small>	5.3	7.3	29.2
808	Bellotti Bianco, Cascina Degli Ulivi, Piedmont 2011 (It) <small>Biodynamic. Nose initially suggests a rich butter pound cake, with nut and citrus oils. Later, with air, the wine has an amazing floral component, almost like lilies, with dry spice, quince and walnuts. The wine has a very good finish with an interesting bitter walnut and churned butter aftertaste.</small>	5.7	7.8	31.2
802	Cheverny Blanc, Domaine du Salvard, Loire 2011 (Fr) <small>Made from 90% Sauvignon and 10% Chardonnay. The nose is full and fruity with elderflower and blackcurrant bud aromas and the creaminess of the Chardonnay fills out the palate providing weight and structure. Intense gooseberry crispness</small>	6.7	9.3	36.9
901	Chardonnay, Tissot, Jura 2008 (Fr) <small>Biodynamic. A fruity and elegant wine. Notes of honey and spice. The mouth is mineral and complex. Aged in oak for 12 months (10% new oak).</small>	6.9	9.6	38.4
138	Riesling, Zind-Humbrecht, Alsace 2008 (Fr) <small>Classic dry style Riesling offering a salty mineral note and laser like acidity with quince, peach and floral notes. This packs a lot of flavour into an elegant and light-weight package.</small>	7.4	10.1	40.3

810	Saumur Chenin Blanc, Roche Nueves, Loire 2010 (Fr) <small>Biodynamic Chenin Blanc. The nose is very attractive, big and perfumed, full of pears, pineapple and honey.
