WINES BY THE GLASS

Focus on...REAL WINES: NATURAL, SUSTAINABLE, ORGANIC, BIODYNAMIC

This is the antithesis of boring, branded wine. Natural wine is something quite individual, very pleasurable and occasionally extraordinary. The central theme to these wines is that they have not had much chemical interference, which means they are still alive in the bottle, and there may be some variation from one bottle to the next. Because of the way they are made some of the wines are fragile and, in order to be properly appreciated, are best served cool.

915	7, Rue de la Pompe, Mas Coutelou, Languedoc 2011 (Fr) A Languedoc Syrah that just soars out of the glass with its freshness and purity, finishing bone dry after a great mouthful of fruit. It is just 12.5% alcohol and has had no added sulphur.	5.4	7.4	29.5
550	Beaujolais Villages, Château Cambon, Beaujolais 2011 (Fr) Gamey, cherry scented offering from natural wine pioneer M Lapierre it is refreshing & very drinkable. From eighty year old vines.	5.6	7.7	30.8
506	Dolcetto d'Alba, Roagna, Piedmont 2010 (It) Very bright, youthful cherry fruit and mineral nose follows through to a feather light, zippy palate.	6.2	8.5	34
562	Wild Vine Carignan, Villalobos, Colchaga 2010 (Ch) Sensuous, delicate, naturally made wine from wild growing vines in the Artist Valley, Colchagua, Chile. 939	La Soif du Mal, 'Les Foulards Rouge', Roussillon 2009 (Fr) Natural winemaking here, with almost no SO2, giving very pure, lush berry fruit & aromatic, sunbaked herbs. 70% Syrah, 30% Grenache, think somewhere between New Zealand Pinot Noir and a deliciously fresh Gamay from Beaujolais. It's light, fragrant and aromatic.	7.6	10.5	41.8
574	Régnié, Charley Thévenet, Beaujolais 2010 (Fr) Like a really fresh, silken Beaune Pinot Noir. Charley has produced a wine that puts Beaujolais back in vogue.	7.9	10.9	43.5
524	Cellar Foot Underwater Syrah, Lammershoek, Swartland 2011 (RSA) Craig Hawkins has taken a few barrels of his best Syrah & submerged them underwater for 11 months! 223	Réserve de Gassac Blanc, Languedoc 2011 (Fr) Predominantly Viognier with Marsanne, Roussanne and Chardonnay from 25 year old vines. It is unoaked. A fleshy nose of tropical fruits and green herbs. Soft and ripe on the palate with a lingering and aromatic finish and a concentrated mineral backbone.	4.4	6.1	23.4
200	The LAM Chenin / Viognier, Lammershoek, Swartland 2010 (RSA) Fresh fruit and acid dominate this Chenin Blanc (60%) and Viognier (40%) blend. On the nose a sense of coolness is the first impression then the subtle fresh flavours of Chenin and Viognier become apparent.	5.3	7.3	29.2
278	Bellotti Bianco, Cascina Degli Ulivi, Piedmont 2010 (It) Nose initially suggests a rich butter pound cake, with nut and citrus oils. Later, with air, the wine has an amazing floral component, almost like lilies, with dry spice, quince and walnuts. The wine has a very good finish with an interesting bitter walnut and churned butter aftertaste.	5.7	7.8	31.2
179	Cheverny Blanc 'Frileuse', Clos du Tue-Boeuf, Loire 2010 (Fr) Nutty, appley and a bit citrusy with pear, herb and savoury notes. Lively and distinctive, with good acidity.	6.7	9.3	36.9
129	Arbois Chardonnay, Stéphane Tissot, Jura 2008 (Fr) Sharp citrus and apple, nutty oak and fresh acidity in this barrel-fermented Jura Chardonnay.	7	9.6	38.4

206	Saumur 'L'Insolite' Chenin Blanc, Roche Neuves, Loire 2010 (Fr) Biodynamic Chenin Blanc. The nose is very attractive, big and perfumed, full of pears, pineapple and honey.
